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Introduction of GUMAMM

- **HPA Quarterly Survey - not timely or comprehensive for performance monitoring**
- **Unify phase 1 data did not cover all aspects of access raised, including**
 - *Why offer of appointments not taken up*
 - *How to monitor patients referred to specialist clinics*
 - *How to monitor access to walk-in clinics*
- **Refine Data Definitions**

GUMAMM... Implementation steps

- Obtain Approval from
 - ✓ Department of Health Sexual Health Programme Board
 - ✓ Independent Advisory Group for Sexual health
 - ✓ BASSH IT
 - ✓ SHA/PCT Sexual Health Leads
- Work with
 - Main Software suppliers
 - Pilot sites

GUMAMM Data Set

GUMAMM develops GUM data , allowing for

- Opportunity to distinguish between walk-in & pre-booked appointments
- Variances between offered and seen
- *Waiting times by referral type

GUMAMM Data Set ...continued

- Patients (self reported) waiting time
- Patients preferred clinic of attendance
- Allowing for the registering of unmet demand
- Access to Specialist clinics

GUMAMM Data Set ...continued

- Includes HIV activity
- Opportunity to assess waiting times for patients self-reporting with symptoms
- *Provides the basis of a data set for PbR Cross charging

GUMAMM – Pilot sites

Pilot Sites included

- Mixture of Urban /Rural
- Regional Mix
- Mixture of IT suppliers
- Large services/smaller services
- Walk-in/Booked services

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GUMAMM – Pilot sites

Pilot Sites

- Blythe Systems – Southend, Sunderland, Mid Essex, Central Middlesex
- Mill Systems – Gloucester, Arrowe Park
- Local Systems – Royal Free, St Georges, Sheffield

GUMAMM – Pilot Results

- All pilot sites recommended that the data should be implemented nationally
- All reported data was required for validation and assurance of the target nationally
- All sites could implement the aggregate report

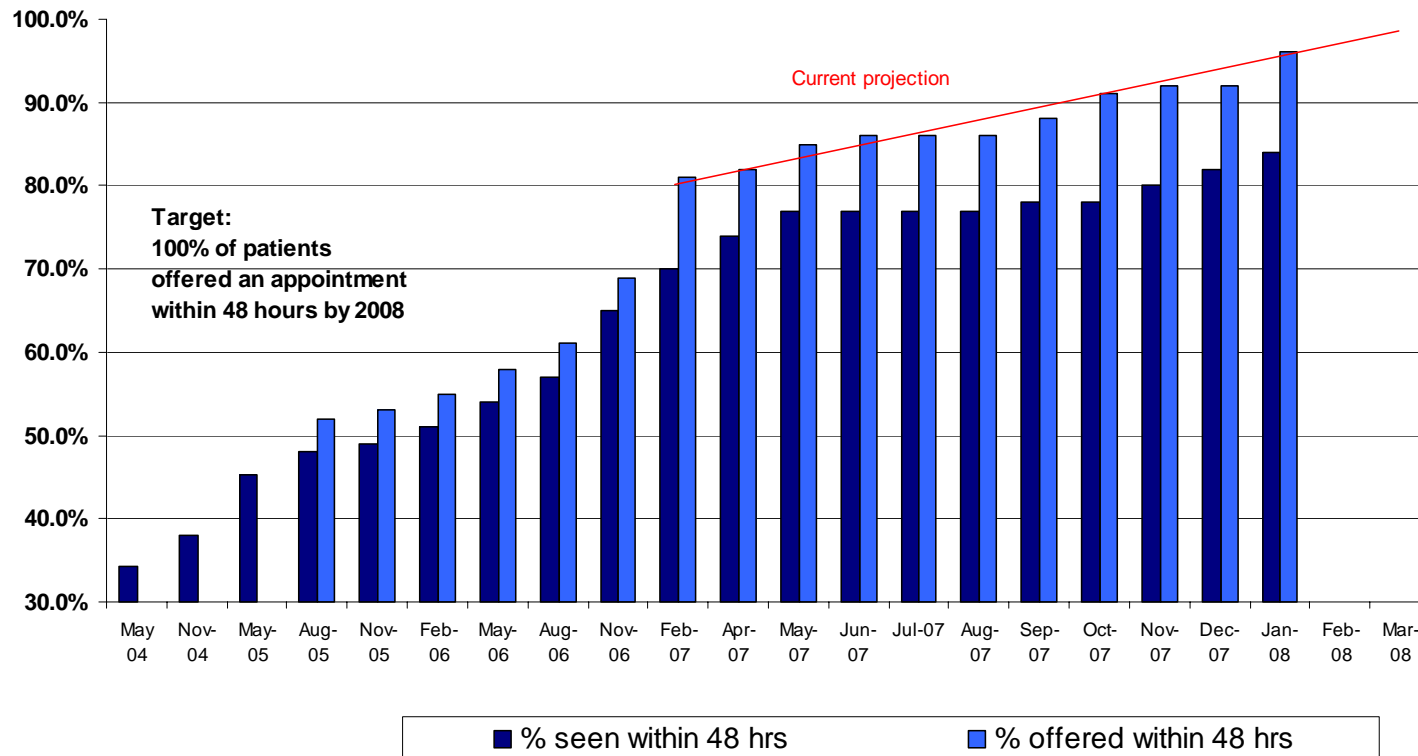

- Unify team/sexual health policy team @DH continue to work on improving the data collection/validation

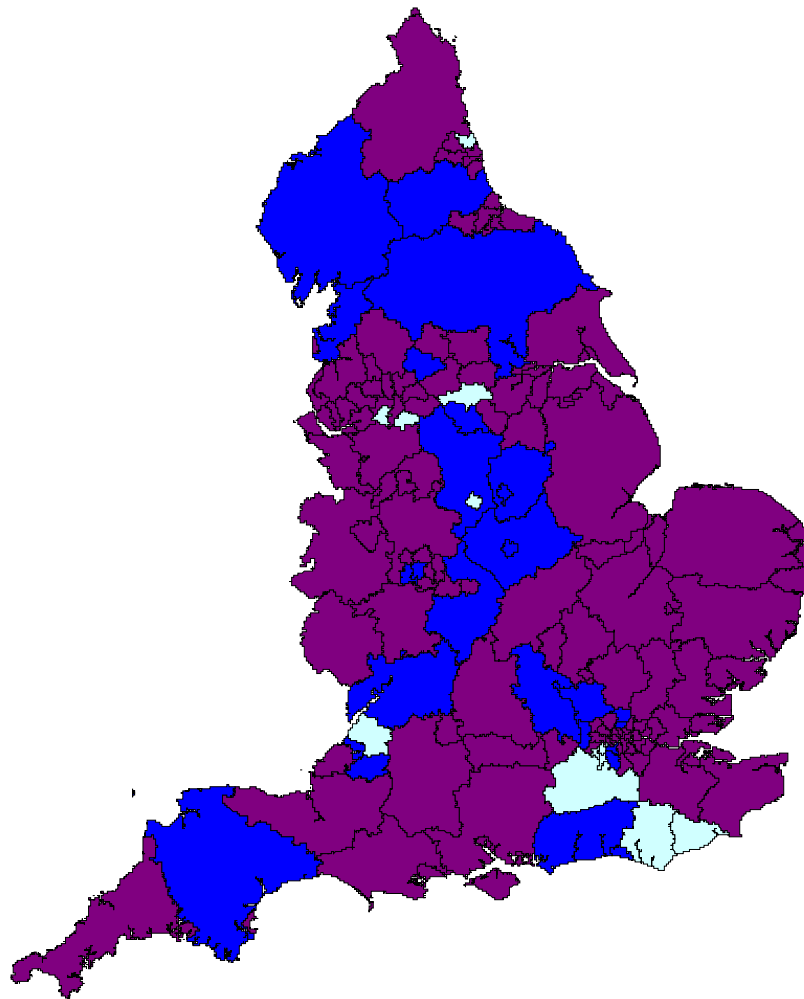
Progress towards GUM 48 hour access target

- Trend over Time

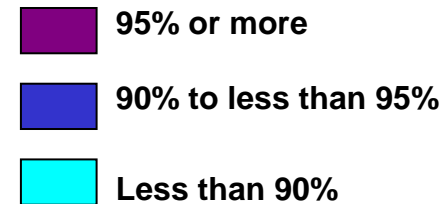


Progress towards GUM 48 hour access target – National Picture

Review of KT31

Contraception Data for Indicator Development and Commissioning

Attendance and Patient Activity (inc Long Acting Reversible Contraception Data) by PCT

Ethnicity, Age, Gender Data

STI testing , diagnosis and treatment by PCT

Training

Record all activity including fertility, psychosexual , abortion, scanning, menopause, brief interventions and level 3 services

Review of KT31

Support Commissioning

Record Full contraception interventions including changes in contraception usage across the year

Approval by end of 2008

Common Data Set for Sexual Health

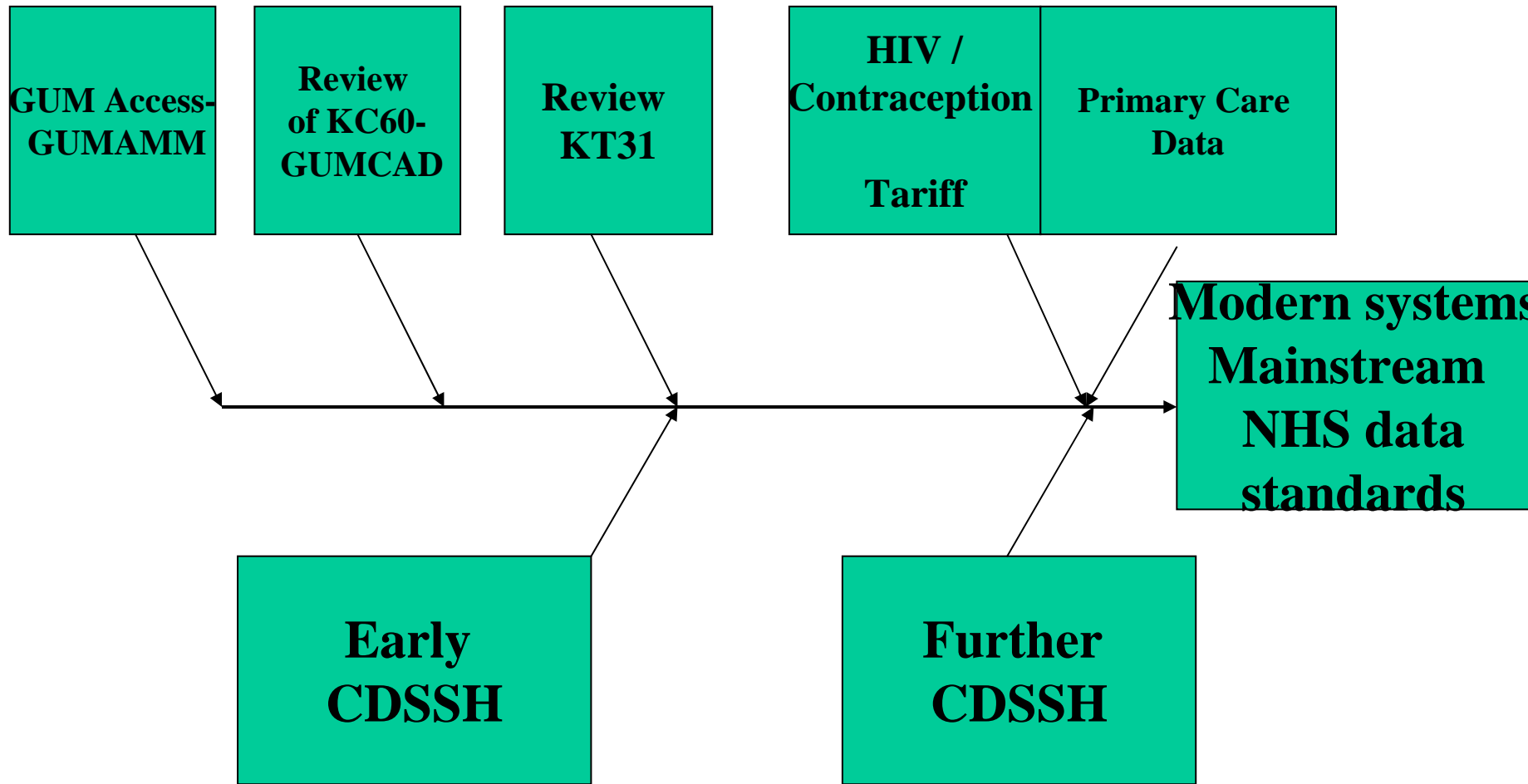
- **Common Data Set - piloted encompassing main clinical settings.**
- **Common Data Set 2nd Stage ISB approval**
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- **Challenges to progress include**
 - No Connecting for Health solution for CDSSH
 - Limitations of Outpatient Minimum Data Set
 - Electronic Patient Record Management System availability in Sexual Health
 - Issues around data anonymisation/ data structures/ data warehousing options
 - GP data flows

Common Data Set for Sexual Health

• *Phased Implementation*

- All data collection under the umbrella of Sexual Health Common Dataset
 - GUM Waiting Time Data – (GUMAMM)
 - Residence based STI data (GUMCAD)
 - Review of KT31 – PCT Level data
 - Improve Primary Care Data
 - Chlamydia Screening
 - Develop better use and analysis of Sexual Health Data

Future Work - ??

Further Develop GUM Tariff

Roll out GUMCAD to all STI testing/treatment sites

Expand GUMCAD for basis of CDSSH

Better reporting of all sexual health data
