What is BASHH?

The British Association for Sexual Health and HIV – BASHH – was formed through the merger in 2003 of the Medical Society for the Study of Venereal Diseases (MSSVD, established 1922) and the Association for Genito Urinary Medicine (AGUM, established 1992). The object of BASHH is:

- To promote, encourage and improved the study and practice of the art and science of diagnosing and treating sexually transmitted diseases including all sexually transmitted infections, HIV and other sexual health problems.
- To advance public health so far as it is affected by sexually transmitted diseases and to promote and encourage the study of the public aspects of sexually transmitted diseases including all sexually transmitted infections, HIV and other sexual health problems.
- To advance the education of the public in all matters concerning the medical specialty of Genitourinary Medicine (hereinafter referred to as 'the Specialty'), to include the management of HIV infections and the broader aspects of sexual health.
- To promote a high standard in the medical specialty of Genitourinary Medicine to include the management of HIV infections and the broader aspects of sexual health

The Association membership includes medical practitioners, scientists in the field of medicine and other healthcare workers who have shown a commitment to the specialty, who have been duly elected Fellows, Members (including Affiliate Members) and Honorary Fellows. Criteria for commitment to the specialty are that the applicant should be currently working in or have contributed to the specialty or an allied field. Honorary Life Fellowship may be conferred on persons, including those not medically qualified, who have given distinguished service to the Association.

BASHH has 4 national meetings per annum, which are held on Friday afternoons. These meetings include the reading of scientific papers by eminent speakers, discussion and the presentation of cases and are held at the Royal Society of Medicine in London. The Annual General Meeting is held in January of each year. In addition, there is an annual Spring Meeting, as well as clinical meetings organised by the Special Interest Groups. A study weekend for doctors in training is held annually, and training for nurses and health advisers are being developed. Educational activities for doctors and other health care professionals working in Sexual Health are also organised at regional level through the Regional Branches. BASHH has a continuing education strategy and is developing additional educational activities and resources.

There are currently over 1,000 members of BASHH, over 80 of whom are overseas members, making it the largest such organizations in the world. Members receive mailings which include information about BASHH and other meetings, courses and a regular Newsletter.

Journals

The annual membership fee for BASHH depending upon membership category includes subscription to one or both of the two affiliated journals; *Sexually Transmitted Infections* and the *International Journal of STD and AIDS*.

Sexually Transmitted Infections

In 1998, *Genitourinary Medicine* changed its title to *Sexually Transmitted Infections* to emphasise the true content and nature of the journal. *Sexually Transmitted Infections* remains the oldest journal in the field dealing with issues of sexual health, sexually transmitted diseases, and HIV. First published in 1925, the journal attracts original articles on the clinical, microbiological, behavioural, epidemiological, social, and historical aspects of sexually transmitted diseases, including viral infections such as HIV and AIDS, human papillomavirus, herpes simplex virus, and the sexually transmissible hepatitis viruses. In 2007-08 the journal had an impact factor of 3.395, which is run by BMA Publishing.

The International Journal of STD & AIDS

This peer-reviewed journal provides a clinically oriented forum for the investigation and treatment of sexually transmissible infections, HIV and AIDS. The contributors, from around the world, promote activities aimed at the research, prevention and control of these infections. The journal contains in-depth editorial reviews, original articles and research, short papers, case reports, audit reports, selected abstracts from leading journals and CPD papers. There is also a lively correspondence column, a book review section, and news from the genitourinary medicine associations. Occasional supplements are also published and are supplied free to subscribers. Subscribers to the *International Journal of STD & AIDS* can access the journal online at no extra cost.

Frequently Asked Questions

Below is a list of the most commonly asked questions regarding membership of BASHH. **Please read these thoroughly before submitting your application or contacting BASHH with a query relating to your application.** If you have a question which is not dealt with below, then please do get in touch with the BASHH Secretariat. What are the benefits of joining BASHH?

BASHH is the largest and oldest association in the field of STI and HIV. For medical and paramedical workers in the field of GU medicine in the UK it is the national specialist society and by joining and supporting it you will help in the promotion of this field. As a fellow/member you will be able to stand for official positions within the association and to vote in elections. Members can register for BASHH meetings at a reduced rate and membership also includes subscription to one or two journals. Members also have access to information contained in the private members area of the website.

How do I join?

Complete the forms contained in this application pack and return them to the BASHH Secretariat. The application needs to be supported and signed by two BASHH members, one of whom should be a Fellow, with personal knowledge of the candidate. The application will then be decided at the next BASHH Board meeting. The proposer and seconder of the candidate may be requested to provide further information if deemed necessary by the Board.

Is my membership automatic?

No. Once you have submitted your application forms it will be processed as described above. You will be notified by the BASHH Secretariat if your application has been successful. Please note that your application will need to be considered by the BASHH Board and so there may be a delay, depending on when the next meeting is due to be held.

Do I have to set up a Direct Debit?

Yes – if you are a member based in the UK. With over 1,000 members BASHH does not have the resources to process this number of individual cheques/credit card payments. By collecting membership subscriptions by Direct Debit we dramatically reduce the amount of administration involved.

The exception to this is for our overseas members who do not have a UK bank account. For these members only we will accept a bank draft made payable to 'BASHH' in pounds sterling, drawn on a UK bank or payment by credit card. For those members who have their subscriptions paid for them by an organisation or company, we would ask that you help us by setting up a personal Direct Debit and then claiming the money back. If you have any queries regarding this, please contact the Honorary Treasurer.

When are subs collected?

Please send your completed application form with a cheque for the 1st membership year. BASHH's membership year runs from 1 August to 31 July. Subsequent year's subscriptions will be collected by Direct Debit at the beginning of August. You will be notified prior to the Direct Debit run.

What happens if I join part the way through the membership year?

The membership fee is reduced to reflect which part of the year you join- see the table- and we ask you to forward a cheque to cover this part year subscription. The direct debit is taken on 31st July.

I would like to join, but don't know two members of BASHH who could support my application. What should I do?

Please contact the BASHH Secretariat who will be able to help you e.g. by providing you with the names of BASHH members within your hospital/locality who you could approach to support your application.

IMPORTANT: Please help us process your application quickly and efficiently by ensuring that you have filled in all forms clearly and completely. There are four forms that you need to complete and return:

- 2. Categories Form**
- 3. BASHH Proposer/seconder form**
- 4. Direct Debit Mandate & a cheque for the 1st year (or for overseas members only, the Credit Card Payment Form)**

Please return the original of the form by POST. Many banks will not accept a faxed version of a Direct Debit mandate.
