## ***Directions to Courtyard Clinic:***

Herewith instructions to get here:

Take southbound Northern Line tube to **Tooting Broadway**. Turn sharp LEFT out from station entrance, walk past Sainsbury's. Cross over at Pelican crossing and walk down Hoyle Road.

Enter St. George's main entrance, walk straight down narrow corridor into Medical School (70yds). Turn LEFT after passing NatWest branch, then walk down another long corridor (Jenner Wing).

After 100yds, you will see a large window showing the new Neurosurgical/Cardiothoracic building. Turn LEFT after the large window, follow corridor past Cardiology into another long but dilapidated corridor into Knightsbridge Wing.

Turn Right (you can't turn left!) and walk down Knightsbridge wing corridor until you get to the far end (100 yds).

**Courtyard Clinic** is the redbrick single-level building to your right.

Go past entrance into reception area and announce your presence!
