Report on the National Audit of the Sexual Healthcare of People with HIV 2006

Case Notes Audit

National Audit Group of the British Association for Sexual Health and HIV

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Summary

This Audit provides data on outcomes that support the management of the sexual healthcare of people with HIV in the UK. The Audit is based on methodology and organisation developed by the National Audit Group of the British Association for Sexual Health & HIV. The data allows Regions to measure practice against specific performance indicators described in national standards and guidelines, as well allowing performance to be compared to that of other Regions and against National average performance. Data on individual clinic performance has already been presented to individual clinics. This Report is intended for use in clinic governance systems as a resource to aid decision-making to improve practice or maintain good practice.

Goals & objectives

The goal of the audit was to improve the management of the sexual healthcare of people with HIV in the UK.

The objectives were to provide data to allow comparison of practice measures against national standards and guidelines, and average UK performances and between:

- Trusts within Regions (Data presented to Regional Chairs only for dissemination to clinics within Regions)
- Regions (this Report)

Case definition

A case was a person with HIV infection diagnosed on or before 31 December 2004 and seen within the audit interval.

Audit interval

Between 01/05/06 and 31/07/06 inclusive.

Sample

The first 30 cases within the audit interval, or all cases seen within audit interval, if less than 30.

Audit process

Planning for the Audit was conducted through the National Audit Group. This involved discussion of the audit process, which data were to be collected, agreement on the final version of audit questions and questionnaire. The audit questions were



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translated into an electronic form that was emailed to Regional Chairs in the form of a *Microsoft Access* database. The questionnaire was sent to clinics in Regions by the Regional Chairs, who arranged for the data in the questionnaires to be entered into the databases. The completed databases were returned by email to a central collection office and collated and analysed. Data were returned during September to December 2006.

Data handling

The Health Service (Control of Patient Information) Regulations 2002 http://www.opsi.gov.uk/si/si2002/20021438.htm came into force on the 1st June 2002.

The Patient Information Advisory Group does not require an application to be made if pseudonymised data is transferred between NHS organisations. The electronic form contained no personal identifiers. Clinics were asked to securely keep a separate record of case note numbers against the unique record identifier provided by the database, and available only to the source clinic. This record linkage was used to check the accuracy of data.

The following process was used to collect data:

- Pseudonymised data collected by clinics on paper datasheets and returned to Regional Chairs.
- Databases emailed to Regional Chairs
- Database populated by offices of Regional Chairs from clinic datasheets and returned by email to central office
- Collated data aggregated by Region
- Collated data aggregated by Trusts within Regions



Conclusions & recommendations

Good performance for hepatitis B testing, but wide regional variations in performance for other indicators. Interventions are needed to improve: hepatitis B vaccination; testing for hepatitis C, syphilis and STIs; aspects of sexual history, safe sex work, cervical cytology and contraception.
